MSR = March, Strathspey & Reel; SOM = Selection of Marches

Bands to be in fine-tuning area about 10 minutes prior to start time.

Fine and retune areas are part of the contest arena in accordance with Rule B.1.15.03.

Bands leaving Circle are not to leave with a drum tap if another band is approaching.

All bands, quintet members and solo drummers must be registered with PBA.

Solo Drummers - accompanying piper required as this is an outdoor contest with no access to power at the solo drumming contest area.

Accompanying pipers for the solo drumming contest are required to wear highland dress.

1. GENERAL

Enquiries on the day to the Contest Supervisor.

2. BAND, QUINTET REPRESENTATIVES and SOLO DRUMMERS

Entry and Sign in from 11.30am Mini Band and Solo Drumming contests commence at 12 noon and Quintets at 2.15pm.

Band, quintet representatives and solo drummers should report to PBV Officials at the Carousel in the Botanical Gardens to :

- a. sign in (a band, quintet or drummer not signed in may be treated as withdrawn from the contest);
- b. collect any late changes to the Draws;
- c. confirm any advice previously provided to the Branch Office;
- d. any withdrawals could result in your timings being advanced;
- e. bands / quintets to ascertain the designated fine tuning areas.

3. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- a. entered Bands must hold a Child Safety Policy.
- b. Judges and Officials hold Working with Children Check certification

4. BAND INFORMATION

- a. **SILENT AREA.** This will be displayed at the Scorers Position. Bands and their members are advised to note the requirement of Rules B.1.07.04 (only to be on the arena whilst competing) and B.1.15.03 (restricting the sounding of instruments on the arena or in the silent area except for Mini Bands or Quintets re-tuning in the designated area). The carousel and solo drumming judge's tent is part of the arena, as is the fine tuning and re tuning areas around the gardens.
- b. **START TIME.** Bands are required to be at the relevant starting point(s) for contest elements ready to compete at the nominated times. The Draw allows a retune time in excess of that specified in Rule B.1.01.04.
- c. **ALTERATION & AMENDMENT TO THE DRAW.** Any request for a variation to the Draw must be made in accordance with Rule B.1.05.04, immediately the relevant circumstances that have arisen.
- d. **CONTEST LAYOUT.** This will be defined by the Contest Supervisor on the day.
- e. **BEHAVIOUR:** Rule A.1.08 applies throughout the day

5. FINALE MASSED BAND at 3.30pm

- a. Drum Major in Charge: Ms Nola Blake
(Vice Principal Dress and Drill; Golden City Pipes and Drums)
- b. The Massed Band will form up in the mini band and quintet contest circle in the Botanical Gardens under the direction of Ms Nola Blake.
- c. **All players assemble by 3.20pm.** Band leaders please liaise with the DMIC for Massed Band format.
- d. Music: Advance: Bonnie Dundee and A Hundred Pipers. Retire: (Static) Scotland the Brave and Badge of Scotland

6. RESULTS AND PRESENTATION PROCEDURE: from 3.35pm

All contest results will be announced at the carousel by PBV Secretary, Prof Euan Wallace AM.

Mini Band results: 3rd, 2nd and 1st in that order will be for Grade 4B SOM, Grade 4B Medley, Grade 4A MSR, Grade 3 Medley and Grade 2 MSR. Pipe Majors / mini band representatives are invited to come forward to receive trophies or certificates from the President of Horsham City Pipe Band, Mr Cameron Whelan and Piping Adjudicator, Mr David Telford.

Quintet results: 3rd, 2nd and 1st in that order for the Quintet contest. Quintet representatives are invited to come forward to receive a trophy or certificate from the Chieftain.

Solo Drumming Contest results: Drummers are invited to come forward to receive medals from Horsham City Pipe Band Secretary Ms Liz Minne and Drumming adjudicators, Dr Ian Bell and Mr Stephen Matthews

7. DRAW

Rule B.1.05 refers. Factors taken into consideration include:

- a. the promoter's requirements;
- b. involvement of tutors;
- c. consideration a Branch's direction under Rule A.1.03.02; concerning order of play;
- d. travelling times. This contest involves performances and meets the criteria between performances specified in Rules B.1.01.03 and B.1.01.04
- e. any directions of the Branch Council
- f. split judging requirements
- g. solo drummers participating in mini bands and quintets.
- h. quintet contest – D.3.04.01 and D 3.05.01 are applicable.


9. VENUE INFORMATION
